

## Adequating our impact...

**WebQuest Description:** This Webquest is intended to provide students with a better understanding of how they can impact their world with some not-very-complicated actions; all of them based on solid information.

**Grade Level:** College / Adult

**Curriculum:** English / Language Arts

**Keywords:** social, impact, renewable, energy, recycling, technology, volunteering, learning

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## Introduction

The objective of this WebQuest is to give students the opportunity to find information to support their involvement in a social impact activity. They must base their decisions and actions on solid information obtained from trusted sites on the web; they must be implementable at a good level in their community, city or (even) their country.

## Tasks

Hello social impactor!! This is what the world needs from you: Find suitable information from trustworthy websites in order to complement 1 of the 3 projects presented. Create alternative that can be implemented in your community; you are seeking to have real social impact onto it.

## Process

Process steps  
1) Organize yourselves in groups of 3-4  
2) Choose one of the three Impact projects proposed  
a) Renewable energies  
b) Recycling technology  
c) Volunteering based on interests  
3) Find information on several sites for each of these impact proposals  
4) Upon collecting the information, use it to present a short social impact project [You will be given 25min to complete the task]  
5) Present your results to the teacher.

## Evaluation

In order to evaluate your work, use the following rubric.  
Range A Information is clear and purposeful; it can be applied by all participants  
Range B Information is clear, but appears unconnected; it could be applied with difficulty  
Range C Information appears incomplete; it may not be applied  
Participation was absent
