### Introduction

Subject/ verb agreement is like making a new friend. When meeting a new friend, you try to find some things that are in common with you. Subject/ verb agreement is just like meeting a new friend. If a subject and a verb do not agree, then the subject and verb dislike each other just like people.&nbsp; So have fun doing the webquest and make the subject and verb become friends!

### Tasks

First the grammar rules for subject/ verb agreement will be read individually. Then for practice, everyone will do a couple of worksheets on subject/ verb agreement. One of the worksheets we will start together in class, and the other worksheet is for homework. The homework will be checked by another student in class the next day we meet. Then take the quiz on the subject/ verb agreement.

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### Evaluation

Student grade for the subject/ verb agreement is based upon the completion of both worksheets (40 points total, 20 per each), the number grade on both worksheets (40 points total, 20 per each), and the quiz grade (20 points total). All of these grades equal to a 100%.&nbsp;
