Introduction

Tasks

Day 2: Research

Today you will be focusing on the research required to make decisions about your high school. You should only focus on the information specific for your group. The handouts you will be using are on the process page. Each group has a handout. Make sure you answer all of the questions in complete sentences. Each handout should be typed and turned in to Miss Jerbi by the end of the class period. Work smarter not harder- if you need to split the task into pairs or individuals make sure you do. Make sure everyone completes the other roles assigned to the group!

Once you have finished the handout you should look at the Panel Worksheet posted below. Each group must fill in the chart. The chart is due tomorrow when class begins.

Process

You should focus on your group's tasks. Ignore the other process applications because you will get distracted and waste time. It is important that you complete all of the tasks assigned to your group on the day they are assigned. If you do not, you may not receive a passing grade for this project.

Evaluation

As upperclassmen you do not need me to read a rubric to you. This means that I expect you to check the rubrics to see how you will be graded. It is your responsibilities to know the expectations.

You will be graded using the rubrics I have attached. You will also evaluate the other members of your group using group evaluation rubric. You must put the person you are evaluating and your name on each rubric.
