

Cyberbullying

WebQuest Description: This lesson is designed to teach students what cyberbullying is, and what to do if it happens to you.

Grade Level: 3-5

Introduction

Cyberbullying involves the use of technology to inflict social cruelty and harm to others, which can include harassment, impersonation, exclusion and stalking. Cyberbullies may use email, chat rooms, instant messaging, text messaging or web sites such as MySpace.com or Facebook.com. Most cyberbullying happens outside of school, but if you're being bullied online, you are probably being bullied in school as well.

Tasks

Students are going to work together to understand the full extent of what cyberbullying is, including how to spot it, and what to do when it is happening to you or someone you know.

Process

As a class, we are going to try and identify key characteristics of cyberbullying and what we think it is. Everyone is going to take a quiz that asks them a series of questions relating to cyberbullying. It can be found at this link here: [javascript:nicTemp\(\);](#) The next day, I am going to put together the results so that as a class we can discuss how much you know about cyberbullying. I have put you into groups of 4 and you will put on a short skit (about 5 minutes) about a topic related to cyberbullying that I have assigned for you. The skits will be filmed by me (unless you are not comfortable with it) and I will post them on our classroom website. Evaluation

You will be evaluated on your ability to demonstrate your understanding of the aspect of cyberbullying that you have been given, as shown through the skit that you present.
